

## **Information for authors of texts published in the Jagiellonian Language Centre's *Glottodidactical Fascicles***

The Jagiellonian Language Centre's *Glottodidactical Fascicles* is a forum for the exchange of teaching experiences of on the part of Jagiellonian Language Centre teachers. The subject those articles published is related to foreign language teaching.

### **1. General principles.**

- 1.1. The article should be written in Polish or English.
- 1.2. The article should contain an abstract and key words in Polish and English.
- 1.3. The article should be written in Times New Roman 12 font, 1.5 interline spacing.
- 1.4. Text organization:
  - name and surname of the author;
  - title in the Polish and English version; if the text is in Polish - first in Polish, if the text is in English - first in English;
  - abstract and key words – just like the title - if the text is in Polish - first in Polish, if the text is in English - first in English;
  - the text of the article with footnotes;
  - bibliography;
  - additional materials (e.g. exercises for students, keys to exercises, materials for teachers)
- 1.5. The principles for writing a bibliography can be found in a paper version at the Jagiellonian Language Centre Office.
- 1.6. The text in an electronic version should be submitted to the Editorial Office of the Jagiellonian Language Centre's *Glottodidactical Fascicles* (2 Krupnicza Street, Room 105) or sent to: [irena.polanska@uj.edu.pl](mailto:irena.polanska@uj.edu.pl).

### **2. Rules for placing original texts**

- 2.1. Texts or fragments of texts used in the content of the article covered by the right of quotation should be provided with the relevant source information (rules regarding printed texts are included in the rules for providing sources in the bibliography; on-line sources should be given by providing a link with the date of access).
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
